**SHORT TENDER NOTICE**

Sealed Tenders are hereby invited on behalf of the Governor of Mizoram from reputed and bonafide manufacturers or their authorized distributors/dealers for the supply of **50mA X-Ray Machine** which will be received by the Director of Health Services, Mizoram, Aizawl on or before **7<sup>th</sup> Sept, 2010 upto 12.00 Noon** under the terms and conditions laid down below.

Quotations are to be opened by Director of Health Services, Mizoram, Aizawl or his authorized representatives at **1:00 p.m.** on the same day. The Tenderers or their representatives may also be present at the time of opening of the Quotations, if they so desire.

**TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. Tenders received from firms and individuals who are not authorized dealers but only authorized to quote on behalf of the manufacturer or dealer shall not be accepted. Authorized dealers should attach Authorization or Distributorship or Dealership, as the case may be, certificates from the concerned Manufacturers. Computer generated letter heads of the manufacturer and such certificates will not be treated as valid authorization. A Gazette Officer or Notary, however, should duly attest Photostat copies. Original Certificate should be produced at the time of opening of the Tender, if demanded.
2. Tenderers must enclose detail specifications of the machine complete with all connected softwares and spares, and other essential or additional accessories considered necessary for the equipment quoted, if any. They must also indicate any other items or facility available, as a package, for upgradation of the equipment, as after sale/installation services, warranty etc. with relevant catalogue/literature of the same
3. Tenders must be submitted in the prescribed form only.
4. Earnest Money amounting to Rs. 16,000/- (Rupees Sixteen thousand) only in case of a Non-Tribal, and Rs. 8,000/- (Rupees Eight thousand) only in the case of Tribal tenderers in the form of Deposit at Call/Fixed Deposit in original, from any nationalized Bank of India or Postal Saving Certificate duly pledged in favor of Director of Health Services, Mizoram, Aizawl must accompany such tender, if submitted.
5. Tenders should be submitted in duplicate and accordingly marked 'Original' or 'Duplicate' as the case may be, on the cover envelopes. The cover of the tender should be super scribed as 'Tender for 50mA X-Ray Machine' addressed to Director of Health Services, Government of Mizoram, Aizawl clearly indicating full postal address of the Tenderer.
6. A non-tribal tenderer should affix a Non-Judicial Adhesive Stamp worth at least Rs. 7.50 and should furnish Photostat copy of valid sales Tax/VAT Registration Certificate or document upto the latest year for which assessment has been made by the concerned authority, and duly attested by a Gazette Officer or Notary. Original Certificate should be produced at the time of opening of the Tender, if demand.
7. A tribal tenderer should furnished Photostat copy of Scheduled Tribe Certificate, MVAT Clearance & Registration Certificate issued by the competent authority. Original Certificate should be produced at the time of opening the Tender, if demanded.
8. Manufacturers submitting their tenders directly should attach Photostat copies of their Manufacturing License, CIN (Corporate Identity Number) and other relevant permissions/licenses required for such manufacturing duly attested by a Gazette Officer or Notary. Original Certificates should be produced at the time of opening of the Tenders, if demanded.

9. A tenderer should quote his/her rates in terms of Indian Rupees inclusive of all taxes and duties and if there are different brands, the separate rates for such brand with specific details of each brand item.
10. Tenderer should quote their rates F.O.R destination
11. All pages of the Tender papers should be printed, signed, stamped and dated; hand written quotation shall not be entertained. Any page or pages not signed, stamped and dated are liable to be rejected. Correction, if any, should be initialed, stamped and dated.
12. If any tenderer violates or fails to fulfill any one of the above mentioned requirements, his or her tender may be liable to be rejected at the time of opening of the tender.
13. Once the rate is accepted by the state Government and communicated to the successful tenderer, the same shall remain valid throughout the life of the agreement as may be executed in due course with the approved tenderer and no further price escalation will be allowed during such validity period which shall normally be a period of 12 months from the date of execution of the agreement and may be extended, if mutually agreed upon by both the parties i.e. Director of Health Services, Mizoram and the concerned Tenderer, subject to recommendation to the State Purchase Advisory Board or the Departmental Purchase Advisory Board, as the case may be.
14. A successful tenderer whose tender has been accepted will have to execute an appropriate Deed of Agreement within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of communication of acceptance of his/her quoted rate(s) by Fax, failing which their Tender will be treated as invalid.
15. A successful firm will have to supply and install the machine within the period fixed by the Department/Authority. If the supply and installation can not be made within the stipulated period without any intimation, the Department has the right to procure the machine from any other sources and the differences in prices, if any, will be realized from the Security Deposit of the approved supplier, as mentioned herein, without assigning any reason thereof.
16. A successful firm will have to furnish Security Deposit of 5% of the value of the supply before issue of supply order in the form of Demand Draft/Fixed Deposit in any nationalized Bank of India or Postal Saving Certificate, as the case may be, duly pledged in favor of Director of Health Services, Government of Mizoram, Aizawl.
17. The Department shall not be bound to accept the lowest rate or any of the tenders even if valid, and reserves the right to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason thereof. The Department shall be at liberty to prefer the quoted rates for the machine of reputed brand/company with ISO specifications compared to other rates. Tenderers having satisfactory performance in the supply, installation, servicing and maintenance of such machine within the state of Mizoram may be given preference. Supporting documents must be enclosed.
18. In case of any legal dispute/litigations arising out of this Tender Notice or its terms, the local courts shall have the jurisdiction as per the relevant laws in force
19. Payments will be made only after the machine are received in full and in good condition to be certified by the Vigilance Committee of the Directorate and after completion of the installation satisfactorily at the respective destination of CHCs/PHCs whatever it is required so. There shall not be any advance payment and no such request shall be entertained.
20. Any attempt for negotiations/campaign, direct or indirect, on the part of a tenderer with the authority to whom he has submitted the Tender or the authority who is competent to accept the same, shall render such Tender liable to be excluded from consideration, if it is so proved.

21. Belated/delayed tenders shall not be entertained in any case. Certificates other than those stated in the foregoing clauses shall be rejected straightaway. Any other/further clarifications in connection with submission of Tender mentioned herein may be made from the Office of Director of Health Services, Government of Mizoram, Aizawl during office hours on all working days.

22. The estimated cost of the materials is Rs.19,50,000/- (Rupees Nineteen lakhs fifty thousand only).
